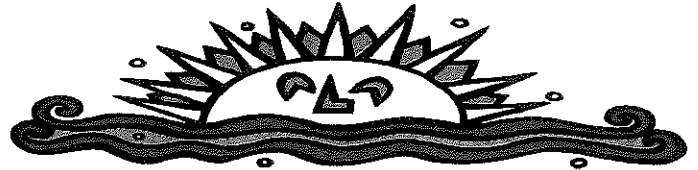

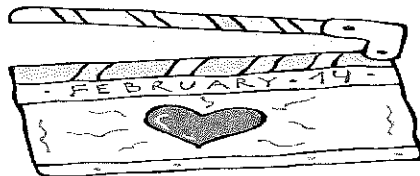
Entertainment was arranged by Blossom Meyerson. We enjoyed an authentic line dancing instruction session. We learned that dance can be a great workout.

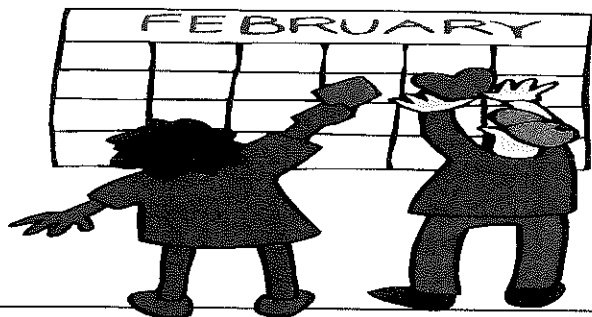
